## <u>DEFENDANT, BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE SYSTEM'S</u> MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Defendant, the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System (hereinafter "the Board"), by and through its attorney, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, hereby moves for summary judgment as to the allegations against it in this case, which arise under the Freedom of Information Act (hereinafter "FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552. The plaintiff submitted its FOIA request to the Board in April, 2009. A statement of material facts not in genuine dispute and a proposed order are also submitted herewith.
